## The Important Bits

## The closing date for this competition is Sunday 27th January 2019

To comply with our insurance, all competitors must be Widnes Ice Skating Club members. Current annual membership re-starts on the 01/02/2019. You must have renewed by this date to ensure you can enter the competition.

Please consult the specific competition criteria and discuss with your Coach before entering and complete an entry form for each competitor. Entries will be accepted on a first come, first served basis. Entries must be received by closing date; late entries will not be accepted. All applications forms need to be filled in on our online booking system. If you need any support in this please do not hesitate to ask any of the committee members. The online form should be compatible with all modern internet devices.

Test level: Competition level is the highest grade/test passed as of the entry deadline date in the discipline the skater is entering. Entrants may skate at a level above that for which they qualify, but they may not skate down in any event. You may only enter one category in your respected discipline, providing you meet the criteria for that level. You may enter multiple disciplines. E.g. figure skating & dance. Entries will be confirmed by email as soon as possible after the closing date (please make sure we have an email address). Once the draw has been completed the skating order will be emailed directly to all competitors.

MUSIC: The official competition music must be emailed in MP3 or Mp4 format to <a href="music.wisc@gmail.com">music.wisc@gmail.com</a>. Your entry will not be accepted without your accompanying music. Music is only required for those performing a programme. Label all music with the following:

Name of skater, category they are skating in. E.g. Phil Jones, Elements free skate Level 3

The length of track and the name of the skater's coach just need to be mentioned in the email. We would appreciate it if you could also provide a contact number in case we need to call you regarding any music related issues and best time to contact.

Age restrictions/requirements: All skaters will be placed into age groups where it does not state an open age category. Juniors will compete separately to adults. Juniors up to the age of 18, Adults from the age of 18 and above. Skaters 16 and above may choose to skate in the Adult categories, but they may not enter the Junior categories if doing so.

Please note: the club refers to juniors under 18 and seniors over 18, but for the purpose of categories Juniors and seniors refers to the level of ability. So we have labelled sections as over 18's or under 18's

REFUND POLICY: Entry fees will not be refunded after entry deadline unless the event is cancelled. In the case of withdrawal entry fees cannot be refunded or transferred to another skater.

LIABILITY: Widnes Ice Skating Club and Planet Ice Widnes accept no responsibility for injury or damage sustained to any participant or their property in this competition.

Children are the responsibility of parents during the competition. Parents are permitted to enter the changing rooms to support their children getting ready, but can we ask that if you do not need to be in the changing facilities, please vacate and wait outside. Ideally the changing rooms are to apply figure skates and last-minute items to costumes. If you need to fully change can we respectfully ask that you use the toilet cubicle in each changing room.
